Brigid and Peter met at Trinity College Dublin where they both graduated in Physiotherapy in 1979. They were the love of each others lives. They were married August 1980 in Athlone, Ireland. Shortly after they moved to Canada as a chance to explore somewhere new. After a year in Newfoundland they moved to Ontario and started their biggest adventures raising a family together. They settled down in Dundas and made strong roots together. There have been wonderful connections with friends, family and the community.
